JOB POSTING: Field Technicians

The Field Technicians will be responsible for cutting brush, drill pad construction, and other duties as assigned.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Comply with safety & health, environmental and Company policies and procedures.
- Brush cutting to support drilling program.
- Build and construct drill pads using hand and power tools.
- Provide drill support logistics to include trail/road maintenance, water well maintenance, waterline distribution, drill alignment, and other drill-related tasks.
- Completes pre-shift inspection and field level risk assessments.
- Other duties as assigned by supervision and may include providing support in other departments as necessary.

While performing the duties of this job, employees may be frequently required to stand, walk, or sit for extended periods of time, use hand and fingers to handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, regularly required to talk and hear. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 75 pounds. Specific vision requirements for this position include close vision, distance vision, and the ability to adjust focus.

This position is a 2 week on 2 weeks off rotation. The 2022 field season has an anticipated duration from the end of January through Fall 2022. The successful candidate must successfully pass a post-offer physical and drug screen and criminal background clearance.

- High School Diploma or equivalent. Must be able to operate a chain saw, power and hand tools and have carpentry skills.
