



JOB POSTING – DRILL SUPPORT TECHNICIAN

Donlin Gold is recruiting for Drill Support Technicians for one of the world's largest undeveloped gold deposits, owned and operated by Donlin Gold LLC, which is owned equally by affiliates of Barrick Gold and NOVAGOLD Resources. Donlin Gold is expected to be one of just a handful of gold mines worldwide that produces more than one million ounces of gold annually.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The successful candidate will assist the geology department with supporting core drilling logistics. The position will support the diamond drill program for the upcoming field program anticipated to begin in January 2022 and run through October 2022. The Drill Support Technicians will work at a fly-in-fly-out remote project site located in western Alaska. The rotation will be 2 weeks on and 2 weeks off, generally working 12-hour shifts.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepare drilling supplies, such as core boxes and run blocks, for field deployment.
- Monitor drilling supply inventory levels and ensure no standby time is accrued as a result of supply issues.
- Assist in supplying site geology department with necessary supplies and monitor inventory.
- Organize core yard laydown as directed by Core Yard Coordinator or Lead Geologist
- Store and catalogue completed drill holes in laydown
- Operate related equipment, if needed.
- Other duties as assigned by the geologists or camp operations.
- Comply with safety & health, environmental and Company policies and procedures.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- High School Diploma.
- Ability to work independently and within a team.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office and Excel software preferred.
- Previous experience working in a remote exploration camp preferred.

While performing the duties of this job, employees may be frequently required to stand, walk, or sit for extended periods of time, use hand and fingers to handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl, regularly required to talk and hear. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 30 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds with assistance.
