INFO | The Standardized Reclamation Cost Estimator (SRCE) is a widely used Excel-based tool for developing mine closure cost estimates to support financial assurance, permitting, and planning. This hands-on training will introduce participants to SRCE V2.0, with a focus on Alaska-specific closure cost practices, scheduling, and cost tracking. The course is designed for mining professionals, regulators, consultants, and financial specialists involved in closure planning and financial assurance.

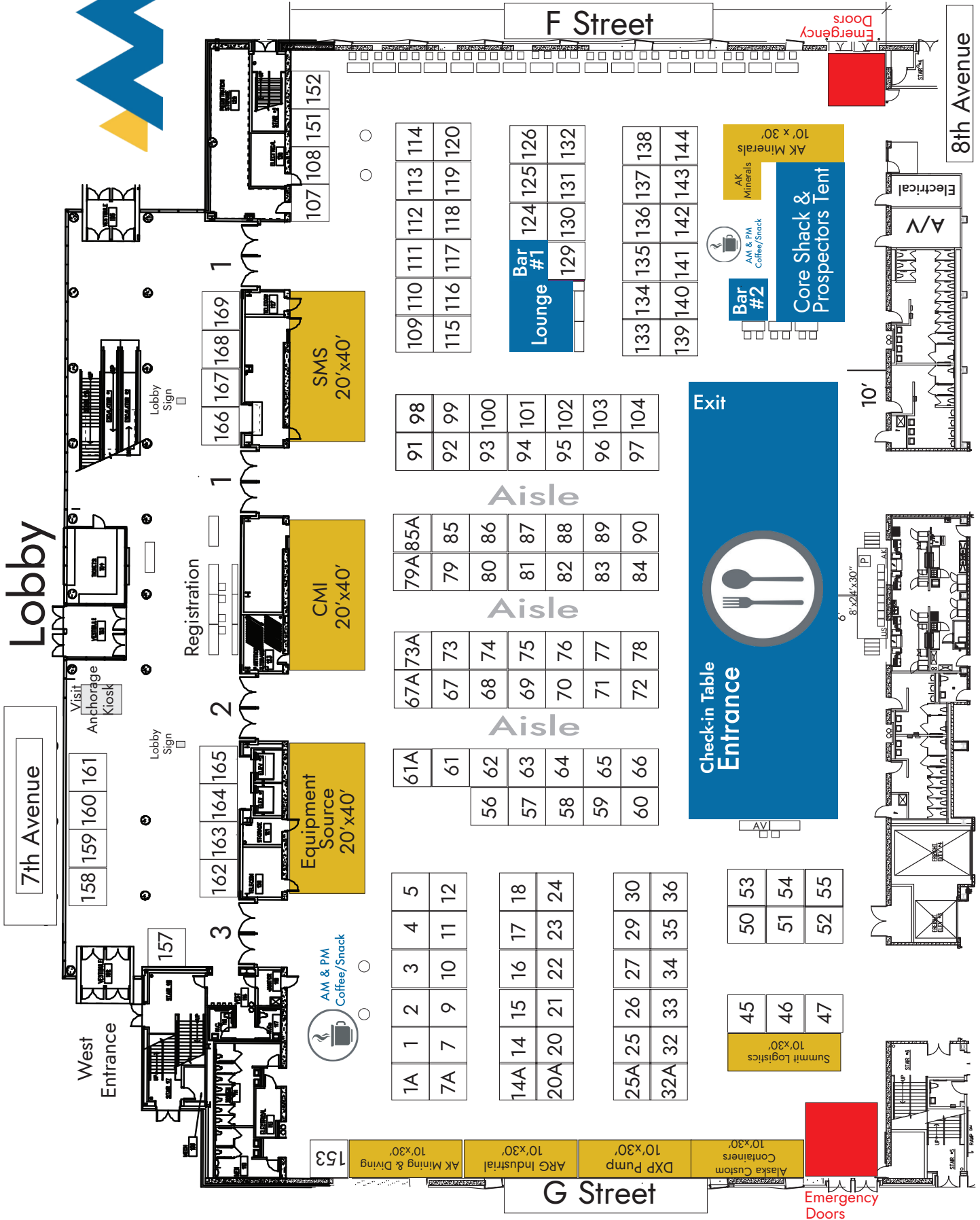
