



## Core Shack and Prospectors Tent

Companies and independent claim holders are invited to participate in the annual core shack and prospector's tent exhibits at the 2024 Anchorage AMA Convention. The core shack is geared toward companies that would like to showcase their best drill core and results to the broader mining and exploration community, while the prospector's tent is designed for independent claim holders to exhibit properties, they are looking for partners on or sell to junior or major companies.

The core shack and prospectors tent exhibits will run from Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup> to Thursday, November 7<sup>th</sup> on the tradeshow floor of the Dena'ina Center from 9 am to 5 pm. Participants will be provided an 8-foot by 6-foot booth space to display drill core, rock samples, posters, maps, and other supplementary materials at no charge; complementary convention passes are provided for up to two booth attendants. AMA encourages participants to have their core shack or prospector's tent booth staffed throughout the convention, with exhibits being removed by the end of the Technical Sessions on Thursday afternoon, November 7<sup>th</sup>.
